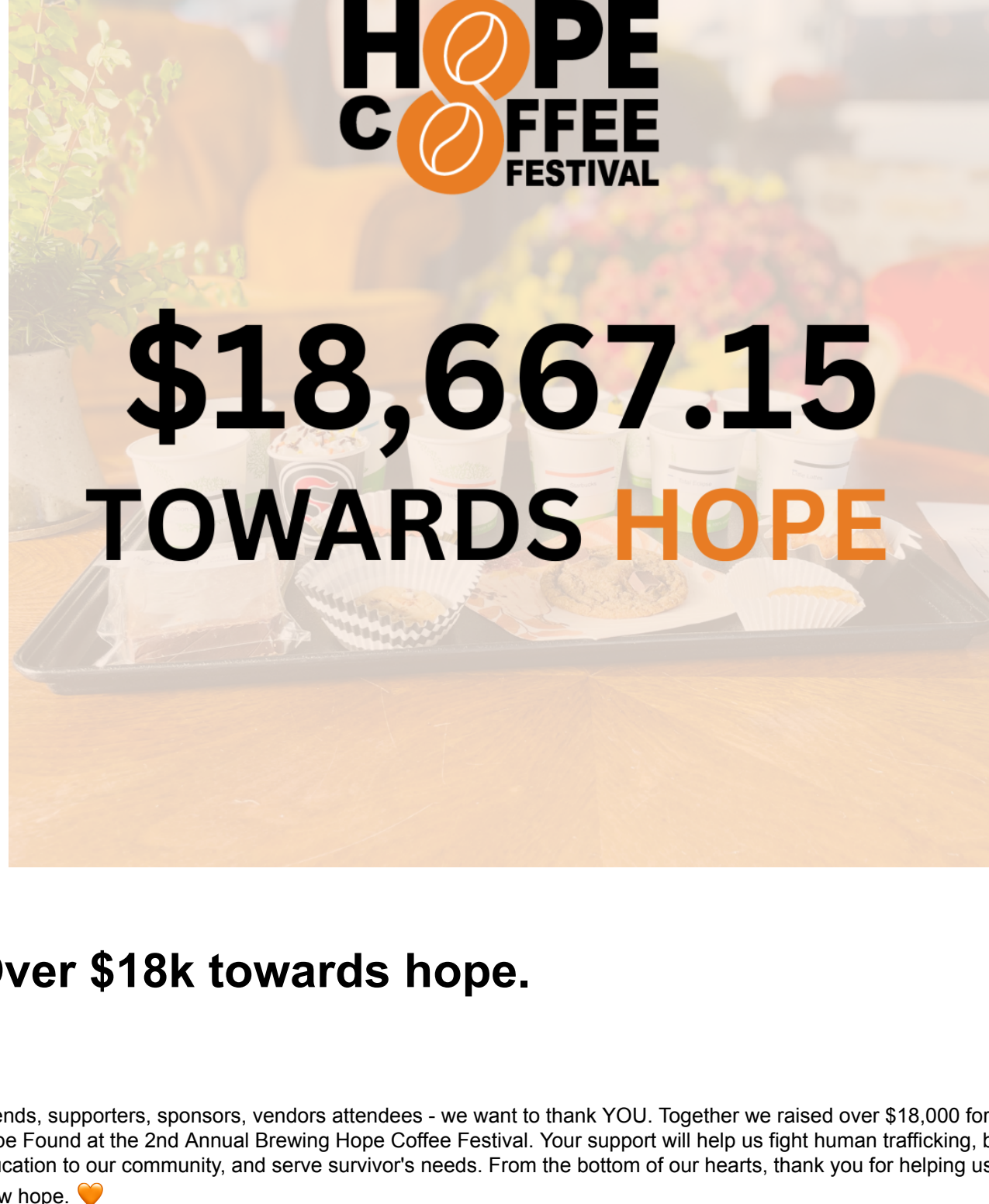


Happy October!

Over \$18k towards hope.

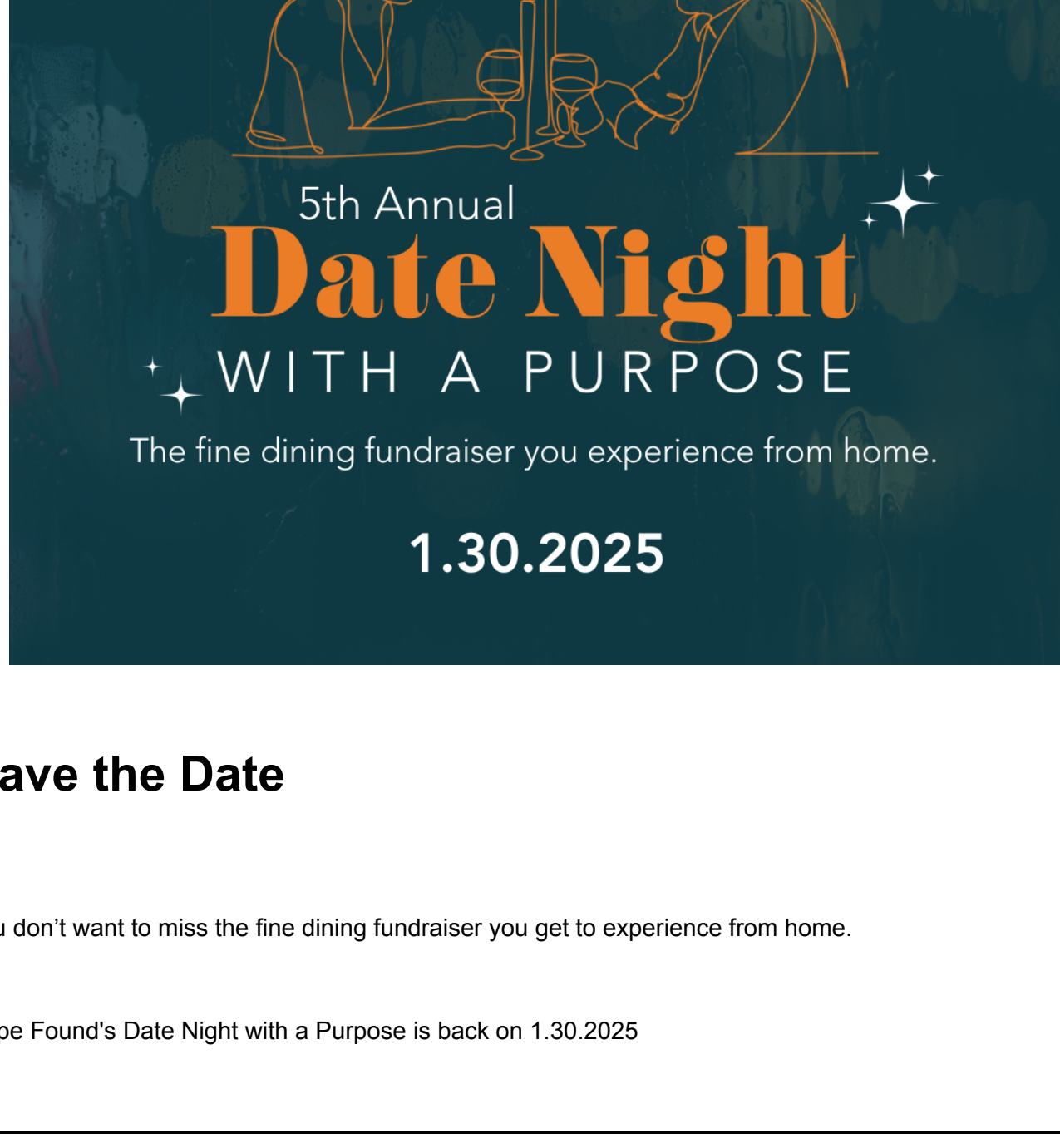

Case management and advocacy services are provided through weekly/monthly check-ins.

- Reviewed information about the criminal justice system and court hearings with clients
- Made referrals to victim services programs and other resources.
- Victim advocacy/accompaniment to emergency medical care and medical forensic exam.
- Provided individual advocacy (e.g., assistance in applying for public benefits).
- Provided Crisis intervention (in-person, includes safety planning, etc.) and On-scene crisis response (e.g., community crisis response).
- Provided individual counseling and emergency financial assistance
- Assisted with writing a victim impact statement
